KEY FEATURES

- Bred in New Zealand by prominent plantsman, Gordon Collier
- Smothered in masses of azure-blue flowers for months on end from mid-spring to late summer and into autumn
- Flowers float atop the plant, like little blue butterflies and are a great attraction for bees and other pollinating insects
- Very attractive, deeply divided foliage provides an impactful textural effect
- An excellent, weed suppressing, filler plant and ground cover for garden borders and cottage gardens
- Cold hardy, drought and heat tolerant
- Evergreen
